

2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-

- [i] As approved by PAB, the recurring grant for State Project Support Unit (SPSU) has been provided for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. April, 2013 except staff salary which was approved from the date of appointment as per ICPS norms. Non-recurring grant for setting up of SPSU has already been provided to the State Government during 2010-11.
- [ii] As approved by PAB, the recurring grant for State Child Protection Society (SCPS) has been provided for 6 months of the current financial year w.e.f. October 2013 except staff salary which has been approved for 3 months of 2013-14. In-principle approval was accorded for grant for supporting Innovative Projects subject to the State submitting these details of the projects. However, as the State has not submitted the details of Innovative Project, the same has not been included in the proposal. Non-recurring grant for setting up of SCPS has already been provided to the State Government during 2010-11.
- [iii] PAB approved recurring grant for 9 months of 2013-14 for 17 DCPUs and 3 months of 2013-14 for 21 DCPUs as per ICPS norms except salary of staff which was approved as per date of appointment of staff. The eligible grants for setting up of DCPUs has been calculated as per the requirement projected by the State and ICPS norms whichever is less.
- [iv] As approved by PAB, the recurring grant for State Adoption Resource Agency (SARA) has been provided for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. April, 2013 except staff salary which was approved from the date of appointment as per ICPS norms. Non-recurring grant for setting up of SARA has already been provided to the State Government during 2010-11.
- [v] PAB approved recurring grants for the 2 existing NGO run SAAs including staff salary for the period April 2013 to March 2014, which were supported under ICPS during 2012-13, as per ICPS norms. PAB also approved entire non-recurring and recurring grant for 8 NGO run SAAs for 3 months w.e.f. January, 2014 as per ICPS norms. (List attached)





The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the CWCs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings.
- [ix] There are 38 existing Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs). PAB has approved, recurring grant for complete year for these existing 38 JJBs as per actual number of sittings and as per ICPS norms except for the salary of Assistant cum Computer Operator which was not approved. The State has informed that the total number of sittings varies from 2 to 6 per week. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the members of the JJBs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings.
- [x] The Government of Bihar shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2013-14.

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the grants-in-aid of Rs. 99,85,37,000/- [Rupees Ninety Nine Crores Eighty Five Lakhs and Thirty Seven Thousand only] as Central share of first instalment for grants-in-aid during current financial year 2013-14 under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme, namely, "Integrated Child Protection Scheme" to the States as per details given below:

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
2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-
- [i] The release of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of recurring grant for the financial year 2013-14, for all existing components/projects under ICPS, to all State Governments who have received grants under ICPS in 2012-13 and four States (Himachal Pradesh, Kerala & Punjab) that received grants in 2011-12 is as per the directions of Secretary (WCD). This release is on ad hoc basis for the financial year 2013-14.
  - [ii] The grant being released as 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment during 2013-14, is 50% of the central share of recurring grant for each component under ICPS as mentioned in the sanction letter issued during 2012-13/2011-12 to each State Governments as listed at Para1(Table) above. Further, the funds being released need to be utilized component-wise only as per the central share mentioned in the sanction letter issued. For E.g.:- The 50% of recurring grant being released for SPSU should only be utilized for SPSU component and not for any other component.
  - [iii] The 2<sup>nd</sup> and final Instalment will be approved subject to the consideration of financial proposal by the PAB, submission of statement of expenditure by the State for Financial year 2012-13 and the grant being released now as first instalment for 2013-14, and approval thereon. Also, any new project/component will be considered in the PAB at the time of release of 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment of the current year. The State Governments will maintain separate records of expenditure incurred for implementation of ICPS and furnish Statement of Expenditure for financial year 2012-13 and the 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment of 2013-14 along with the Implementation Report.
  - [iv] The State Governments/UT Administrations shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2013-14.
  - [v] It is certified that Rule 209(6)(iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt.
  - [vi] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.
  - [vii] It is certified that 'Rule 212(5) is not applicable to this grant.
  - [viii] It is certified that all the principles of Rule 215(2) of GFR have been kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt.
3. The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of the Principal Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Women and Child Development, D-Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. **The payment of the State Governments would be arranged through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.** The State Accountant Generals will send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to the Principal Pay & Accounts Office, Ministry of Women and Child Development, D-Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.

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4. The expenditure involved is debitable to Major Head 3601; Grants-in-aid to State Government; 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes; 358-Social Welfare – Child Welfare; 07-Integrated Child Protection Scheme[ICPS]; 07.0031-Grants-in-aid; Demand No.105, Ministry of Women and Child Development for the year 2012-13 (Plan).
