




- [i] As approved by PAB, the recurring grant including staff salary for State Project Support Unit (SPSU) has been provided for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. April, 2013. Non-recurring grant for setting up of SPSU has already been provided to the State Government.
- [ii] As approved by PAB, the recurring grant including staff salary for State Child Protection Society (SCPS) has been provided for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. April 2013. In-principle approval was accorded for grant for supporting Innovative Projects subject to the State submitting these details of the projects. However, as the State has not submitted the details of Innovative Project, the same has not been included. Non-recurring grant for SCPS has already been provided to the State Government during previous financial year.
- [iii] As approved by PAB recurring grant including salary was approved for all 26 DCPUs for full financial year 2013-14. Sponsorship Grant was approved for all districts for full financial year. After-Care Fund has not been provided as the State has not requested for it. Non-recurring grant has already been provided to the State Government.
- [iv] As approved by PAB, recurring grant including salary was approved for SARA for full financial year 2013-14. Non-recurring grant has already been provided to the State Government.
- [v] PAB approved recurring grant for Eight (8) Government run SAAs and (1) NGO run SAAs for 12 months of the current financial year 2013-14.
- [vi] PAB approved maintenance grants for existing 26 Government run Homes and 26 NGO run Homes for full financial year based on occupancy and actual staff in position. Further, recurring grants have also been provided, except rent component, for 2 additional NGO run Children's Home at Surendranagar from the date of sanction i.e. from 1st October, 2013. The maintenance grants under ICPS to the State Government for these Homes have been provided as per the norms and sharing pattern of the ICPS in this financial year.

- [vii] The recurring grants for 26 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for complete year except for salary of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator which, will be provided after confirmation of their appointment. As per the information provided by the State Government, the total number of sittings in CWCs is 4 per week. The calculations have been carried out for each CWC as per the number of meetings indicated against them.
- [viii] The recurring grants for 26 existing Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs) have been provided for complete year except for salary of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator which, will be provided after confirmation of their appointment. The State has informed that the total number of sittings in JJBs per week varies from 1 to 4. The calculations have been carried out for each JJB as per the number of meetings indicated against them.
- [ix] The Government of Gujarat shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2013-14.
- [x] It is certified that Rule 209(6)(iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt'.
- [xi] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.



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
2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-
- [i] The release of 1st instalment of recurring grant for the financial year 2013-14, for all existing components/projects under ICPS, to all State Governments who have received grants under ICPS in 2012-13 and four States (Himachal Pradesh, Kerala & Punjab) that received grants in 2011-12 is as per the directions of Secretary (WCD). This release is on ad hoc basis for the financial year 2013-14.
 - [ii] The grant being released as 1st Instalment during 2013-14, is 50% of the central share of recurring grant for each component under ICPS as mentioned in the sanction letter issued during 2012-13/2011-12 to each State Governments as listed at Para1(Table) above. Further, the funds being released need to be utilized component-wise only as per the central share mentioned in the sanction letter issued. For E.g.:- The 50% of recurring grant being released for SPSU should only be utilized for SPSU component and not for any other component.
 - [iii] The 2nd and final Instalment will be approved subject to the consideration of financial proposal by the PAB, submission of statement of expenditure by the State for Financial year 2012-13 and the grant being released now as first instalment for 2013-14, and approval thereon. Also, any new project/component will be considered in the PAB at the time of release of 2nd instalment of the current year. The State Governments will maintain separate records of expenditure incurred for implementation of ICPS and furnish Statement of Expenditure for financial year 2012-13 and the 1st Instalment of 2013-14 along with the Implementation Report.
 - [iv] The State Governments/UT Administrations shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2013-14.
 - [v] It is certified that Rule 209(6)(iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt.
 - [vi] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.
 - [vii] It is certified that 'Rule 212(5) is not applicable to this grant.
 - [viii] It is certified that all the principles of Rule 215(2) of GFR have been kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt.
