[v] As approved by PAB recurring grants to 1 NGO run SAA i.e. Lawei Baphymai, Project of Reach Shillong Ministries already being supported under ICPS, has been provided as per ICPS norms for 2013-14.

[vi] Government run Homes

PAB approved recurring grants for existing 4 Govt. run Homes (1 Shelter Home, 3 Observation Homes) for complete financial year 2013-14 as per ICPS norms as per actual number of beneficiaries.

PAB also approved non-recurring grant for 18 Homes and recurring grant to 3 additional Govt. run Children's Homes for which in-principal was accorded during 2012-13 for 7 months of 2013-14 as requested by the State Government as per ICPS norms. For the remaining 15 additional Homes, recurring grants were approved for 3 months of 2013-14 as requested by the State Government as per ICPS norms.

PAB also approved non-recurring and recurring grant for 7 additional NGO run Homes, from December, 2013 as per ICPS norms and as per actual number of beneficiaries.

- [vii] As approved by PAB recurring grants has been provided for complete year to 1 NGO run Open Shelter i.e. Reach Shillong Ministries already being supported under ICPS.
- [viii] There are 7 existing Child Welfare Committees (CWCs). As approved by PAB, recurring grant for 7 existing CWCs for complete year has been provided based on the number of sittings taking place in CWCs. PAB also approved the non-recurring grant for the proposed 4 CWCs and recurring grant for 3 months w.e.f. January, 2014 as requested by the State based on the number of sittings taking place in CWCs. The State has informed that number of CWC sittings varies from 2 to 3 per week. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the CWCs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings.
- [ix] There are 7 existing Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs). As approved by PAB, recurring grant for 7 existing JJBs for complete year has been provided based on the number of sittings taking place in JJBs. PAB also approved the non-recurring grant for the proposed 4 JJBs and recurring grant for 3 months w.e.f. January, 2014 as requested by the State based on the number of sittings taking place in JJBs. The State has further informed that number of JJB sittings varies from 2 to 4 per month. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Social Workers of the JJBs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings as provided by the State Government.
- [x] The Government of Meghalaya shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary Statement of Expenditure in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2013-14.
