[vii] PAB approved maintenance grant for 5 Government run Homes except for rent based on actual occupancy for 12 months as per ICPS norms. (3 Observation Homes, 1 Special Home, 1 After Care Home). No maintenance grant was considered for the Observation Home at Karnal as there is no beneficiary in the Home.

PAB also approve salary for only 2 Homes (Observation Home cum special home, Ambala and Observation Home, Hissar) as requested by State Govt.

Construction grant was approved for three new Government run Homes (1 Observation Home for Boys at Karnal and two Children's Home at Rohtak and Hansi).

PAB approved maintenance grant for 4 NGO run Children's Homes based on actual occupancy for 12 months as per ICPS norms.

PAB approved recovery of the grant of Rs. 18.06 lakhs released during 2007-08 under the erstwhile scheme 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' for construction of Homes at Hissar and Ambala as the State has informed that they have received construction grant twice under the JJ Scheme during 2007-08 and later under ICPS during 2010-11.

- [viii] As decided by PAB in-principle approval was accorded for 2 new Open Shelters subject to submission of details of NGOs and locations by State Government.
- [ix] As approved by PAB, recurring grant except for rent and the salary of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator have been provided for all 21 CWCs for 4 months as requested by State Govt. The State has informed that the CWCs meet between 0 to 2 times per week. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the CWCs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings, no grant has been provided to CWCs where no. of meeting is 0.
- [X] As approved by PAB, recurring grant except for rent and the salary of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator have been provided for all 21 JJBs for 4 months as requested by State Govt. The State has informed that the JJBs meet between 0 to 6 times per week. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the JJBs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings, no grant has been provided to JJBs where no. of meeting is 0.
- [xi] The Government of Haryana shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2011-12.
- 3. The above grants-in-aid will be released to the Government of Haryana through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur Branch, Nagpur.
- 4.
