- [viii] As No District Need assessment has been done, the requirement of an Open Shelter will be considered only after receiving a proposal from the State govt. with supporting data.
- The non-recurring and recurring grants for 4 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for complete year. As per the information provided by the State Government, CWCs meets twice a month. The calculations have been carried out for each CWC as per the number of meetings indicated against them. Grant has been approved for CWCs, however, they have been asked to be reconstituted as per the JJ Act norms.
- [x] The non-recurring and recurring grants for 4 existing Juvenile Justice Boards [JJBs] have been provided for complete year. As per the information provided by the State Government, JJBs meets twice a month. The calculations have been carried out for each JJB as per the number of meetings indicated against them.
- [xi] The Government of Sikkim shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2011-12.
- 3. The above grants-in-aid will be released to the Government of Sikkim through Cross Cheque in favour of 'Secretary, Finance Department, Government of Sikkim'.
