- PAB accorded in principle approval of recurring grant for State Project Support Unit [i] [SPSU] for 6 months, to be released in the second instalment for 2012-13, subject to confirmation from State regarding appointment of staff. Non-recurring grant for setting up of SPSU has already been provided to the State Government as per ICPS norms during 2010-11.
- PAB accorded in principle approval of recurring grant for State Child Protection [ii] Society [SCPS] for 6 months, to be released in the second instalment for 2012-13, subject to confirmation from State regarding appointment of staff. Further, in principle approval was accorded for General Grant-in-aid for innovative project, subject to the State providing details for the same. Non-recurring grant for SCPS has already been provided to the State Government during 2010-11.
- PAB accorded in principle approval of recurring grant for District Child Protection [iii] Units [DCPUs] for 6 months, to be released in the second instalment for 2012-13, subject to confirmation from State regarding appointment of staff. Sponsorship and After care Fund was approved for all Districts, for 6 months only, to be released at the time of 2nd instalment for the year 2012-13, if staff has been appointed in the DCPUs. Non-recurring for aforesaid 19 DCPUs have already been provided to the State Government.

- [iv] PAB accorded in principle approval of recurring grant for State Adoption Resource Agency [SARA] for 6 months, to be released in the second instalment for 2012-13, subject to confirmation from State regarding appointment of staff. However, as approved by PAB salary for one Programme Manager who is already appointedhas been provided for 12 months in SARA. Non-recurring grant for setting up of SARA has already been provided to the State Government as per ICPS norms.
- [v] As requested by the State Government, the recurring grants for 13 existing NGO run Specialized Adoption Agencies (SAAs) has been provided for complete year and recurring grants for 1 additional SAA has been provided from date of sanction as per the norms of ICPS Scheme. The non-recurring grant for 2 SAAs have been provided to the State Government as per ICPS norms.
- [vi] Maintenance grants based on occupancy to 27 existing Government run Homes have been provided for complete year as per ICPS norms. The State has submitted its proposal online and the maximum no. of children for which grant can be requested is 50 per unit. The State has informed that the actual number of children is much more than 50 children. Therefore, as approved by PAB maintenance grant has been provided as per the actual number of children submitted by the State in the proposal.

The Children's Homes at Murshidabad and Malda would be provided the grant, subject to the State furnishing details regarding beneficiaries. Grants to 3 Specialised Units for Children with Special Needs in the existing Homes have also been provided.

Maintenance grants based on occupancy to 26 existing NGO run Homes have been provided for complete year as per ICPS norms. Moreover, grants to 12 Specialised Units for Children with Special Needs in the existing Homes have also been approved. Grants were not approved for Shelter Home at Dakshin Dinajpur as it has no beneficiaries.

Grant was not approved for the 2 additional Homes proposed by the State, as the Home at Nadia has no beneficiaries and there is a complaint pending against the organisation (Chiranabin) running the other, regarding which the State's report is awaited.

In principle approval was accorded for upgradation grant for all 5 homes proposed by the State, and construction grant for one Home at Malda, as per ICPS norms, subject to details of upgradation/construction proposed in each home and PWD estimates being provided by the State.

[vii] The grant for 22 existing Open Shelter has been provided for 12 months of the current financial year w.e.f. from April, 2011. The State has submitted its proposal online and the maximum no. of children for which grant can be requested is 25 per unit. The State has informed that the actual number of children is much more than 25 children. Therefore, as approved by PAB maintenance grant has been calculated as per the actual number of children submitted by the State in the proposal. The non-recurring grant for setting up of Open Shelter has already been provided during the previous year grant.

- [viii] The recurring grants for 19 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for complete year, subject to confirmation by State regarding appointment of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator. As the State has not confirmed the appointment of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator, salary for the same has not been provided during the current financial year. As per the information provided by the State Government, the number of meeting per week varies from 4 to 8 in respective CWCs. The calculations have been carried out for each CWC as per the number of meetings indicated against them.
- [ix] The recurring grants for 19 existing Juvenile Justice Boards [JJBs] have been provided for complete year, subject to confirmation by State regarding appointment of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator. As the State has not confirmed the appointment of Assistant cum Data Entry Operator, salary for the same has not been provided during the current financial year. As per the information provided by the State Government, the number of meeting per week is 5 in respective JJBs. The calculations have been carried out for each JJB as per the number of meetings indicated against them.
- [x] The Government of West Bengal shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2012-13.
- [xi] It is certified that Rule 209(6)(iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt'.
- [xii] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.
