

PAB also approved non-recurring grants (including upgradation grants) and recurring grant for 11 additional NGO run Homes for complete financial year 2014-15, which have been provided as per revised ICPS norms and actual number of beneficiaries (refer Annexure – 3 & 4 of 1st instalment).

- [vii] **CWCs**: As approved by PAB, recurring grants including salary of Data Entry Operators (DEOs) have been provided for complete financial year 2014-15 for 8 CWCs as per revised ICPS norms and number of sittings per week taking place in 8 CWCs, as stated by States.
- [viii] JJBs: As approved by PAB recurring grants have been provided for all 8 JJBs including salary of DEOs and rent for 6 JJBs for the complete year 2014-15 as per revised ICPS norms and actual number of sittings per week taking place in 8 JJBs.
- [ix] The Government of Mizoram shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary Statement of Expenditure/ Utilization Certificate in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2014-15.
- [x] It is certified that Rule 209(6) (iii) of GFR, have been kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Govt'.
- [xi] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.
