2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-

- [i] The release of 1st instalment of recurring grant for the financial year 2014-15, for all existing components/projects under ICPS, to all State Governments of North Eastern States (except Sikkim), who have received grants under ICPS in 2013-14 is as per **the directions of Secretary (WCD)**. This release is on ad hoc basis for the financial year 2014-15.
- [ii] The grant being released as 1st Instalment during 2014-15, is 25% of the central share of recurring grant for each component under ICPS as mentioned in the sanction letter issued during 2013-14 to each State Government as mentioned in Para 1 (Table). Further, the funds being released need to be utilized component-wise only as per the central share mentioned in the sanction letter issued. For E.g.:- The 25% of recurring grant being released for SPSU should only be utilized for SPSU component and not for any other component.

- [iv] The State Governments shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary Statement of Expenditure in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2014-15.

- [vi] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.

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

- [i] SPSU : As approved by PAB recurring grants is calculated for SPSU as requested by the state and as per ICPS norms except for salary of the staff which was not approved as SPSU will be phased out in the FY 2015-16.
- [ii] SCPS : PAB approved recurring grants including salary of staff from Nov'2014 to Mar'2015 (5 months) as the State informed that staff will be recruited by Nov'2014. PAB approved After Care Fund for complete financial year and the same is calculated. Funds for innovative projects under General grant-in-aid have not been calculated.
- [iii] DCPUs (11 existing) : As approved by PAB non-recurring grant is calculated for 4 new DCPUs only. PAB had also approved recurring grant including salary of staff from Nov'2014 to Mar'2015 (5 months) in 8 DCPUs as the state has informed that staff will be recruited by Nov'2014 and the same has been provided as per ICPS norms.
- As approved by PAB Sponsorship and foster care fund is calculated for 8 DCPUs for complete financial year 2014-15 and as per ICPS norms.

- [v] Government run Homes (11 existing) : Recurring grant was approved by PAB for 11 existing Homes for complete financial year as per actual no. of children and staff etc. subject to state submitting separate calculation sheet for each Home and actual no. of children in these Homes and the same has been calculated accordingly (Annexure - A).

(12 New proposed) PAB had also approved non-recurring and recurring grant for 12 new proposed Homes from the date of sanction (Dec.2014 to March 2015). However, no grant is provided as the State Govt. did not furnished details.






