2. The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-

- [i] The recurring grants for **State Project Support Unit [SPSU]** has been provided for **three months of the current financial year**. Non-recurring grant for purchase of furniture, equipments etc. has been provided in the current financial year of 2010-11.
- [ii] The recurring grants for **State Child Protection Society [SCPS]** has been provided for **three months of the current financial year**. Non-recurring grant for purchase of furniture, equipments etc. has been provided in the current financial year of 2010-11. The State Government has been provided **Rs.20 Lakh under the General Grant-in-Aid to support need based/innovative intervention programme for carrying out base line survey on child protection situation in the State**.
- [iii] The recurring grants for setting up of **38 District Child Protection Societies [DCPSs]** has been provided for **one month of the current financial year**. Non-recurring grant for **38 DCPSs** has been provided in the current financial year 2010-11. The **foster care fund** has been provided for **3 districts @ Rs.50,000/- per district**.
- [iv] The recurring grant for **State Adoption Resource Agency [SARA]** has been provided for **one month of the current financial year**. Non-recurring grants for purchase of furniture, equipments etc. has been provided in the current financial year of 2010-11.
- [v] The recurring grants for complete year to **1 existing Adoption Coordinating Agency [ACA]** has been provided during 2010-11.

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- [vi] The recurring grants for 1 existing Specialised Adoption Agency [SAA] has been provided for complete year. The recurring grants for 2 Licensed Adoption Placement Agencies [LAPAs] to be re-designated as Specialised Adoption Agencies [SAAs] has been provided for five and a half months of the current financial year i.e. from 15.10.2010. The 3 new SAAs which have been approved in principle will be considered at the time of second instalment for 2010-11. Non-recurring grants for 3 SAAs has been provided in the current financial year 2010-11.
- [vii] The maintenance grants of 14 existing Homes [1 Special Home, 10 Observation Homes and 3 Children's Homes) being run by the State Government have been provided as per the norms and sharing pattern of the old scheme i.e. 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' for a period of six and half months (April, 2010 to 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2010) in this financial year. The maintenance grants for these homes have been provided as per the norms of the Integrated Child Protection Scheme from 16.10.2010 onwards. The salaries of the staff and rent component as per the norms of ICPS have not been included as these have to be provided as per actual. Hence, Salaries and rent component will be considered at the time of release of second instalment for 2010-11.
- [viii] The grants for 11 Open Shelters which have been approved by the PAB in principle will be provided at the time of release of second instalment for 2010-11.
- [ix] The recurring grants for 21 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for 11 months of the current financial year. The recurring grants for remaining 17 new CWCs have been provided for three months of the current financial year. Non-recurring grants has been provided for all 38 CWCs in the current financial year.
- [x] The recurring grants for 38 existing Juvenile Justice Boards [JJBs] have been provided for 11 months of the current financial year. Non-recurring grants has been provided for all 38 JJBs in the current financial year.
- [xi] The Government of Bihar shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2010-11.

3. The above grants-in-aid will be released to the Government of Bihar through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur Branch, Nagpur.

4. The expenditure involved is debitible to Major Head 3601; Grants-in-aid to State Government; 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes; 358-Social Welfare – Child Welfare; 07-Integrated Child Protection Scheme[ICPS]; 07.0031-Grants-in-aid; Demand No.104, Ministry of Women and Child Development for the year 2010-11 (Plan).


