

- [i] As **approved by PAB**, only non-recurring grant for setting up of State Project Support Unit [SPSU] has been provided during the current financial year.
- [ii] As **approved by PAB**, only non-recurring grant for setting up of State Child Protection Society [SCPS] has been provided during the current financial year.
- [iii] As **approved by PAB**, only non-recurring grant for setting up of District Child Protection Society [DCPS] has been provided during the current financial year.
- [iv] As **approved by PAB**, only non-recurring grant for setting up of State Adoption Resource Agency [SARA] has been provided during the current financial year.
- [v] As decided by the PAB no grant has been sanctioned for Adoption Coordinating Agency [ACA] during 2010-11.
- [vi] As decided by the PAB no grant has been sanctioned for Specialised Adoption Agency [SAA] during 2010-11.
- [vii] As **approved by the PAB**, up-gradation and maintenance grants to existing 4 Government run Homes have been provided. The maintenance grant under ICPS to the State Government for these Homes have been provided **as per ICPS norms from 16.03.2011 onwards and as per the norms of old scheme i.e. A Programme for Juvenile Justice for the earlier period (i.e. from 01.04.2010 to 15.03.2011).**
- [viii] As decided by the PAB no grant has been sanctioned for Open Shelters in Urban and Semi-Urban Areas during 2010-11.
- [ix] *The non-recurring and recurring grants for CWCs are allowed from the date of signing of MOU. In the instant case the MOU has been signed on 30.06.2010. As approved by the PAB, recurring grant excluding rent component for existing 7 CWCs has been provided w.e.f. 01.07.2010 [i.e. for 9 months of the current financial year]. No rent has been provided to these 7 CWCs. Non-recurring grant has been provided in the current financial year. The State Government has informed that 1 CWC meets thrice a week and the remaining 6 CWCs meet twice a week. The calculations have been done accordingly.*
- [x] *The non-recurring and recurring grants for JJBs are allowed from the date of signing of MOU. In the instant case the MOU has been signed on 30.06.2010. As approved by the PAB, recurring grant excluding rent component for existing 7 JJBs has been provided w.e.f. 01.07.2010 [i.e. for 9 months of the current financial year]. No rent has been provided for these 7 JJBs. Non-recurring grant has been provided in the current financial year. The State Government has informed that 1 JJB meets twice a week and the remaining 6 JJBs meet once a month. The calculations have been done accordingly.*

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3. The above grants-in-aid will be released to the **Government of Meghalaya through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur Branch, Nagpur.**
4. The expenditure involved is debitable to Major Head 3601; Grants-in-aid to State Government; 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes; 358-Social Welfare – Child Welfare; 07-Integrated Child Protection Scheme[ICPS]; 07.0031-Grants-in-aid; Demand No.104, Ministry of Women and Child Development for the year 2010-11 (Plan).
