- The above-mentioned grant is subject to the under mentioned conditions:-
- [i] The recurring grant for State Project Support Unit [SPSU] has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year i.e. for the month of March, 2011. Non-recurring grant for SPSU has been provided in the current financial year.
- [ii] The recurring grant for State Child Protection Society [SCPS] has been provided for 2 months of the current financial year w.e.f. February, 2011 except for the General Grant-in-Aid component for innovative programme. No fund has been provided for the General Grant-in-Aid component as the State has not provided any details regarding the innovative programme they wish to do. Non-recurring grant for SCPS has been provided in the current financial year.
- [iii] The recurring grants to 33 District Child Protection Societies [DCPSs] have been provided for 2 months of the current financial year w.e.f. February, 2011 except for the staff salary which has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year. No rent has been provided as the State Government has not requested for it. Non-recurring grant for all 33 DCPSs have been provided in the current financial year.
- [iv] The recurring grant for State Adoption Resource Agency [SARA] has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year i.e. for the month of March, 2011. The State Government has requested for 2 Programme Officers on the basis of geographical spread which has been provided. Non-recurring grant for SARA has been provided in the current financial year.
- [v] No grant has been provided for setting up of Adoption Coordinating Agency [ACA] in the current financial year of 2010-11.

- [vi] The recurring grant for 2 existing Specialised Adoption Agencies [SAAs] has been provided for complete year. For 3 new SAAs, recurring expenditure has been provided from the date of sanction i.e. 16.02.2011 (for 1 and half month of the current financial year). The State Government has requested for maintenance of building for the existing 2 SAAs instead of rent component, which has been provided. The non-recurring grant for all 5 SAAs has been provided as per the requirement projected by the State Government. The State Government may utilize the central share of amount released under this component during 2009-10 as committed liabilities for the year 2010-11
- [vii] No grant has been provided under the Institutional Care component as the State Government has not yet returned with the revised proposal after rationalizing the requirement of Homes.
- [viii] The grants for 2 existing Open Shelters have been provided for complete year for 4 units. The State has requested for 5 contact points and 5 outreach workers for 2 units (shelters) of one organization which has been provided. The non-recurring grant for these Shelters has been provided in the current financial year of 2010-11. The State Government may utilize the central share of amount released under this component during 2009-10 as committed liabilities for the year 2010-11.
- [ix] The recurring grants for 24 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for complete year. For the remaining 9 CWCs which are being constituted, recurring grants has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year. No rent has been provided for 32 CWCs as these are located in Homes. Rent has been provided to 1 CWC located in Pratapgarh district which is not located in a Home.
- [x] The recurring grants for 23 existing Juvenile Justice Boards [JJBs] have been provided for complete year. For the remaining 10 JJBs which are being constituted, recurring grants has been provided for 2 months of the current financial year w.e.f. February, 2011. The State Government has informed that all JJBs sit thrice a week. The travelling/meeting allowance of 2 Social Workers has been calculated @ 3 meetings per week. No rent has been provided to 32 JJBs as these are located in Homes. Rent has been provided to 1 JJB located in Pratapgarh district which is not located in a Home.
- [xi] The Government of Rajasthan shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2010-11.
- The above grants-in-aid will be released to the Government of Rajasthan through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur Branch, Nagpur.
- 4. The expenditure involved is debitable to Major Head 3601; Grants-in-aid to State Government; 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes; 358-Social Welfare Child Welfare; 07-Integrated Child Protection Scheme[ICPS]; 07.0031-Grants-in-aid; Demand No.104, Ministry of Women and Child Development for the year 2010-11 (Plan).
