- [i] The recurring grant for **State Project Support Unit [SPSU]** has been provided for **1** month of the current financial year **i.e.** for **March**, **2011**.
- [ii] The recurring grant for State Child Protection Society [SCPS] has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year i.e. for March, 2011 except for the salary of 1 Accountant and 1 Data Entry Operator on fixed remuneration of Rs.8,000/- per month and Rs.5,000/- respectively for 5 months of the current financial year w.e.f. 01.11.2010 to 31.03.2011.
- [iii] The recurring grants for 19 District Child Protection Societies [DCPSs] have been provided for 1 month of the current financial year i.e. for March, 2011 except for Sponsorship and Foster Care fund. The salary of 1 Accountant and 1 Data Entry Operator on fixed remuneration of Rs.8,000/- per month and Rs.5,000/- respectively has been provided for 5 months of the current financial year w.e.f. 01.11.2010 to 31.03.2011.

- [iv] The recurring grant for State Adoption Resource Agency [SARA] has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year i.e. for March, 2011 except for the salary of 1 Accountant and 1 Data Entry Operator on fixed remuneration of Rs.8,000/- per month and Rs.5,000/- respectively for 5 months of the current financial year w.e.f. 01.11.2010 to 31.03.2011. The salary of the Programme Manager on fixed remuneration of Rs.20,000/- per month is provided for 4 months of the current financial year w.e.f. 01.12.2010 to 01.03.2011.
- [v] The recurring grants for 1 new Adoption Coordinating Agency [ACA] from the date of sanction i.e. for 4 months of the current financial year w.e.f. 01.12.2010 to 01.03.2011 has been provided during 2010-11.
- [vi] The recurring grants for 1 existing Specialised Adoption Agency [SAA] has been provided for complete year and for 14 Specialised Adoption Agencies [SAAs] which have already been formed, recurring grants has been provided from the date of sanction i.e. from 01.12.2010 (for 4 months of the current financial year). For 5 new SAAs recurring grants has been provided for 1 month of the current financial year i.e. for March, 2011. The non-recurring grant has been provided in the current financial year of 2010-11.
- [vii] All existing Homes which were getting grants earlier have been provided grants for complete year. Up-gradation of 4 Government run Homes and 1 Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) run Home as proposed by the State Government has been provided. The maintenance grants under ICPS to the State Government for these Homes have been provided as per the norms and sharing pattern of the old scheme i.e. 'A Programme for Juvenile Justice' for a period of 8 months (April, 2010 to November, 2010) in this financial year. The maintenance grants for these homes have been provided as per the norms of the Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS) from 01.12.2010 onwards.
- [viii] The grants for 24 existing Open Shelters have been provided for complete year as per the norms of the erstwhile scheme, namely, 'An Integrated Programme for Street Children'. The grants for 34 new Open Shelters would be considered after they were justified by a detailed survey.
- [ix] The recurring grants for 19 existing Child Welfare Committees [CWCs] have been provided for complete year except for the staff salary. The salary of the Assistant cum Data Entry Operator has been provided for 2 months w.e.f. February, 2011.
- [x] The recurring grants for 19 existing Juvenile Justice Boards [JJBs] have been provided for complete year except for the staff salary. The salary of the Assistant cum Data Entry Operator has been provided for 2 months w.e.f. February, 2011.
- [xi] The Government of West Bengal shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary utilization certificates in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2010-11.

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- 3. The above grants-in-aid will be released to the Government of West Bengal through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur Branch, Nagpur.
- 4.
