6. The expenditure is debitable to the `3601" in Demand No. 108, Ministry of Women & Child Development under sub-head; 02- Grants for State Plan Schemes, 02.358-Social Welfare-Child Welfare, 05-Integrated Child Development Services, 05.01-General Component, 05.01.31-Grants-in-aid 2015-2016 (Plan).

7. The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of the Principal Pay and Accounts Office, Ministry of Women and Child Development,, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. The Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the Deptt. of Women & Child Development will draw and disburse the amount of **Rs.3,88,36,000/-** to the Govt. of Sikkim through a crossed Demand Draft.

8. The pattern of grants has already been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme approved by the Ministry of Finance.
