

**PROJECT PROFILES-INTEGRATED CHILD  
DEVELOPMENT SERVICES PROJECTS - 1978**

The Report on the "State of Preparedness of the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Projects", gave the general results of the Baseline Study (1976). The present volume on 'Project Profiles, published in 1978, gives a detailed account of each of the selected 29 ICDS projects highlighting, in particular, the nutrition and health problems.

Under the nutrition profile of each project, general dietary pattern, the dietary pattern of pregnant and lactating mothers and of the children (0-5+), the nutrition programme under the Applied Nutrition Programme (ANP), Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP) and the Integrated Child Development Services are given. The health profile discusses common diseases, the diseases among pregnant and lactating mothers and among the children (0-5+), environmental conditions and drinking water, health infrastructure, ICDS infrastructure, etc.

Of the 29 projects analysed individually, 17 were rural projects, 8 tribal and 4 urban. The rural projects included (1) Kambadur (A.P.), (2) Dhakuakhana (Assam), (3) Tarapur (Bihar), (4) kathura (Haryana), (5) T.Narasipur (Karnataka), (6) Kangan (J&K), (7) Vengara (Kerala), (8) Singroli (M.P.), (9) Ukhurul (Manipur), (10) Nurpur Bedi (Punjab), (11) Thally (T.N.), (12) Nilakottai (T.N.), (13) Chawmanu (Tripura), (14) Shankaragarh (U.P.), (15) Dalmu (U.P.), (16) Jawan (U.P.) and (17) Man Bazar (West Bengal). The tribal projects included (1) Utnoor (A.P.), (2) Barajamda (Bihar), (3) Chhota-Udepur (Gujarat), (4) Pooh (H.P.), (5) Tokapal (M.P.), (6) Dharni (Maharashtra), (7) Subdega (Orissa) and (8) Garhi (Rajasthan). The urban projects included those in Bombay, Madras, Calcutta and Delhi.
