
#### **Preface**


This booklet is an attempt to orient them about children's development and provide suggestions for activities and experiences that parents can do with their children.




## Responsibilities of a parent

# Development of children and related parental experiences








Children need to run, jump, and climb

Children need first hand experiences, explanation for processes








Children need first hand experiences, understand cause and effect relationship and think logically

Children need opportunities for interaction, discussion and exposure to books








Children should have a positive self concept, understand their emotions and control their aggression
